



Garda Vetting Policy

The Board of Management of Glynn NS will comply fully with the requirements of Circular 0031/2016 with regard to the vetting of teaching and non-teaching staff. Garda vetting will also be a prerequisite for those who through a voluntary, helping or coaching capacity may have unsupervised access to children.

Children travelling to school matches and other school related events will, as far as practicable, travel on buses subsidised by the Board of Management. In keeping with our Health & Safety statement children must return to school on the bus unless the school has received written instructions from parents/guardians to the contrary.

All ancillary staff will be Garda vetted every two years.

As well as the statutory requirements for Garda vetting the following groups of people will be asked to submit Garda vetting

- Members of the Parents Association
- Members of the Board of Management
- Parents who accompany class teacher to swimming, library, etc.
- Facilitators of the "You Will Be My Witnesses" & "Grapevine" Programmes

The Board has designated Joe Ryan as the School Contact Person. The Board also designated Patricia Creen to deputise for the Contact Person during his absence.
