The school has an emergency evacuation procedure, which is carried out on a regular basis, but at least once a term.

Fire exits are clearly identified as per the school's Health and Safety Statement (which is available for inspection in the school). These fire exits are kept accessible at all times. A basic first aid kit is available in the school for minor injuries but in the event of an emergency both the parents and the emergency services will be contacted.

A review of the Health & Safety Statement will be facilitated by each incoming Board of Management during their first year.
