16:30	Arrival	Arrival through the front entrance at the National Opera House. Please take a quick roll call to ensure everyone is present. The Sing Out Loud team and attendants will be on hand to greet your schools.
16:50	Meet & Greet	The pupils will be introduced to the Sing Out Loud team, our MC Tony, children's conductor Naoimh and stage manager Colin and we will brief everyone on the activities for the remainder of the day.
17:00	Moving Backstage	A Sing Out Loud attendant will meet you again and you will be escorted backstage and place you in your allocated seating on the stage.
17:30	On Stage Rehearsal	Dress rehearsal will commence with the Children, Naoimh and the Orchestra
18:30	Break	A Sing Out Loud Attendant will be assigned to meet you to bring you to your allocated dressing room where children can eat their packed lunch.
19:00	Concert	A Sing Out Loud attendant will collect you to bring you back to the stage
